

SLaM Recovery College and Covid Safety

The recovery college team is pleased to be able to offer courses and workshops at Ortus and Dulwich Picture Gallery after an 18-month long pandemic pause on face-to-face teaching. As the impact of the pandemic eases, we will return to delivering the curriculum across all of SLAM's geographical areas.

As the college is part of the services offered by South London and Maudsley NHS Foundation Trust, we need to follow the current NHS Covid safety rules. Within our classrooms, this means that all students and trainers will need to always maintain 2 metres social distance and wear face coverings. The college will provide disposable face coverings at both venues for those who do not have them, and hand sanitizers to use throughout the time you spend with our team.

At the present time, we are unable to offer course places to people who think they won't be able to tolerate wearing a face covering. However, the college is continuing offer a wide range of online courses and workshops using Microsoft Teams and we encourage you to enrol for these options if you find wearing a face covering difficult. We understand that this may disappoint some students and we will be reassessing this guidance when NHS regulations are updated.
